Birmingham Institute for Psychodrama HOW TO FIND US

WOODBRIDGE HOUSE 9 WOODBRIDGE ROAD MOSELEY BIRMINGHAM B13 8EH

(Woodbridge House is the location of the offices and rehearsal studio of Geese Theatre Company, and also the premises of the Birmingham Institute for Psychodrama)

As you look at the front of Woodbridge House, Number 9 is a door of glass and wood, next to a motor tuning garage. BIP is located through this door and one floor up.

ARRIVING BY TRAIN and BUS

From New Street Station or Moor Street Station

From either Station you can take a taxi which will cost approximately £6 or a bus straight to Moseley Village which will take around 15 mins.

The No 50 bus starts from Moor Street Queensway opposite Moor Street Station.

From New Street Station, leave via the main exit (past car park and taxi rank), turn left under the bridge and it is a two minute walk to the bus stops. The Number 50 runs very frequently and will drop you in Moseley Village outside the Co-op Supermarket and Sainsbury's Local on the left. This is just past Woodbridge Road.

On exiting the bus, turn back on yourself and walk up the street to the Lloyds TSB Bank. Turn right onto Woodbridge Road and Woodbridge House is approximately 50 yards along the street on your left (above the garage.)

ARRIVING BY CAR

From the M42 Motorway

- 1. Leave the M42 at junction 3 (A435) and follow the signs to Birmingham.
- 2. At the first island take the 2nd exit and continue along the dual carriageway (A435).
- 3. At the next island, the dual carriageway ends but continue on the A435 (2nd exit) following the signs.
- 4. You will pass through a small parade of shops continue down this road, Alcester Road South. At the next set of traffic lights go straight over and you will drive through Kings Heath High Street.
- 5. As the High St. comes to an end you will approach a set of traffic lights. Go in the right hand lane and follow the road round to the right, up a slight hill. You are now entering Moseley. Follow the road round and you will arrive in Moseley Village. As the houses end and the shops begin there is a pay and display car park on your right (next to Kingfisher take away).
- 6. Go straight over the next set of traffic lights and take the second right into Woodbridge Road (Lloyds TSB Bank on right hand side).
- 7. Woodbridge House is approximately 50 yards along the road on the left-hand side (directly above the garage.)

From the M6, Junction 6

- I. Follow A38(M) to the City Centre
- 2. After 2 miles the road becomes elevated, and at the end of this section of road the Queensway tunnel begins. Pass under the first segment, the second and the third, and when the tunnel ends you will find yourself on Bristol Street.
- 3. Continue straight on, through the traffic lights where you will see a McDonalds on your right and Bellevue Health Clinic on your left. You are now on the Bristol Road. Continue straight on for approx 1.5 miles.
- 4. At the next traffic light junction turn left onto Edgbaston Road. You will pass the Edgbaston Cricket Ground on your left just before arriving at a roundabout. Take the 2nd exit to Moseley Village (Salisbury Road). Follow the road to the traffic light crossroads, and turn left.
- 5. Continue along this road and take the second right into Woodbridge Road (Lloyds TSB on right-hand side)
- 6. Woodbridge House is approximately 50 yards along the road on the left-hand side (directly above the garage.)

PARKING

There is some on-road parking around Woodbridge House. However, please be careful as much of the parking is restricted to a one-hour limit. Do not park anywhere where there are "no parking" notices as the wheel clampers are quite vigilant.

There is a Pay and Display car park in Moseley Village, opposite the Post Office, approximately 200 yards from Woodbridge House.
